The church was a hood one. Bishop
Bernard 1204-14 confirmed it to the
Church of St Andrew of Marnick
Yorkis, and the Nuns there, to hold
and appropriate, as the charter of
dominus Adam, son of Adam de
Levington (d 1210) testified, and reserved
episcopal rights. Bishop Hugh 1219-23
Confirmed to the same nuns the church of St
Andrews - juxta - Carlisle to hold and convert in
hereditions & usus, provided that they appointed
a vicar. The vicar was not taxed in 1291,
because his benefice was worth 4 marks
only, but the portion belonging is the
vicarage of Marnick was rated at £ 3.
